



Tech Prep Teacher Instructions 2019 Sinclair/MVTPC Showcase Thursday, April 18, 2019

We are looking forward to your attendance at the 2019 Sinclair/MVTPC Showcase! This year's Showcase will be held in Building 12 at Sinclair Community College. We have a full day of activities planned for your schools' teams, and the experience will create memorable moments for your students in preparation for career development opportunities. Below, please review the Showcase procedures:

1. **Arrival:** 8-8:45 a.m. Sinclair personnel will be at the door to welcome all teams at the main entrance of Building 12 on Perry Street. Please have all students prepared for some candid photos upon entering the building. "Ambassadors" will escort you and your team to your table location in Building 12 for set-up. Sinclair police will assist your buses, vans and cars while unloading students and presentation supplies on Perry Street. **Please DO NOT enter the horseshoe drive with vehicles.** Buses remaining for the duration of the event are to park in the parking lot at Building 20 located across the bridge on 4th Street. Bus drivers will be provided with a lunch ticket. Low clearance cars and vans may park under Building 12 on West 4th Street parking garage will be open (no cost).
2. **Information:** An information area will be located in the Great Hall. Each student will have information on their corresponding tables regarding lunch information, The People's Choice Award and directions for the speaker and award ceremony.
3. **Breakfast Snack:** There will be 3 snack bars in the Great Hall from 8:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m.
4. **Floor Questions:** All registered teams will have a 6' table or a round table for presentations. The team's name card will be on their assigned table. Please remember to bring your **own table covers, power strips, and cords for electricity.** **Tech Prep team members will be all around Building 12.** They can help trouble-shoot any problems.

6. **Judging:** Judging will commence promptly at 9:00 a.m. Judges will determine the order in which teams are evaluated. There will be 180+ judges in attendance who are donating their time and expertise. All judges have connections to the pathway field and should have a full five minutes to ask questions of the team following the team's ten-minute (max) presentation. **Judges will review the project summaries prior to the students' arrival at the team table.** However, it is up to the students to take the lead in the presentation/explanation of their projects and then answer judges' questions.

If you arrive later than 10:30 – you won't be judged.

We have invited Sinclair staff, school district building administration, and guests to observe the event, so it is imperative that the students **remain at their table until 10:45 a.m.** *Please ensure that your students are respectful of neighboring teams as they are being judged.* Final scores will be tabulated by the Tech Prep Tally Team.

7. **Lunch:** MVTPC will host lunch starting at 10:50 a.m.
8. **Awards:** As requested, we will have an awards ceremony in the **Great Hall** for your students from 12:15 to 1:00 p.m. Lindsay Pitstick, MVTPC assistant director, will host the ceremony and Dr. Raul Soto will present the awards. Tech Prep Showcase champions will receive a team trophy and individual team member medallions. Runners-up will receive a team trophy. Additional trophies will be awarded to the competition's overall highest scoring team for "Best of Show" and the "People's Choice Award".
9. **Dress and Behavior:** Each high school chaperone is responsible for the students they bring to the Showcase. This is a **professional event**. Students should dress for the occasion and their behavior is expected to be respectful and professional for the duration of the event. All Sinclair Community College security requirements will be enforced and the Sinclair police will be on standby for any emergencies to aid staff and students. Please tell students to secure all valuables and bring only what they need for the day.
10. **Emergencies and Building 12 Facilities:** Emergencies should be reported to the Building 12 Corporate Office, located at the south end of the great hall. Restrooms are located in the north and south hallways on the first floor.
11. **Departure:** Following the awards ceremony at 1:00 p.m., buses may load in the horseshoe area of Perry Street or by the 4th Street parking meters, which will be reserved for the event.
