



Miami Valley Tech Prep Consortium Benefits

Sinclair Community College and the Miami Valley Tech Prep Consortium (MVTPC) are dedicated to providing students the opportunity to earn a post-secondary education or get started on a career faster and at less cost. MVTPC partners with high schools to connect students to career exploration and college credits by providing the following opportunities:

- Pathway specific **Career Exploration** by participating in campus tours, hands on activities in campus labs, and engaging with faculty about a variety of college credentials and career opportunities.
- Provide **college credit options** that align with Ohio's Career Technical Education (CTE) pathways. MVTPC collaborates with college faculty to provide course alignment and requirements for students to complete college credits.
- Hosting the annual **Tech Prep Showcase** for all MVTPC high schools, at which students showcase their CTE skills through demonstration of a project and presentation.
- MVTPC students are eligible for **two scholarship opportunities** post-high school. Students with financial need who complete their CTE concentrator requirements and earn above a 2.25 high school GPA, are eligible for the \$3,000 Sinclair Tech Prep Scholarship paid out over four semesters. All MVTPC graduates automatically receive the BOGO Summer Scholarship. Sinclair will cover the cost of 3 credit hours when a student registers for at least 6 credit hours during one or both of the first two summer semesters post-high school graduation.
- **Streamlined transition to Sinclair** with no need for an additional college application, eligibility to bypass the placement test for students with above a 2.8 GPA, and facilitation of earned college credit.
- Collaborate with Sinclair College Credit Plus (CCP), Transition Advising, and Tech Prep West Region to aid in completion of **college pathways, and professional development.**
